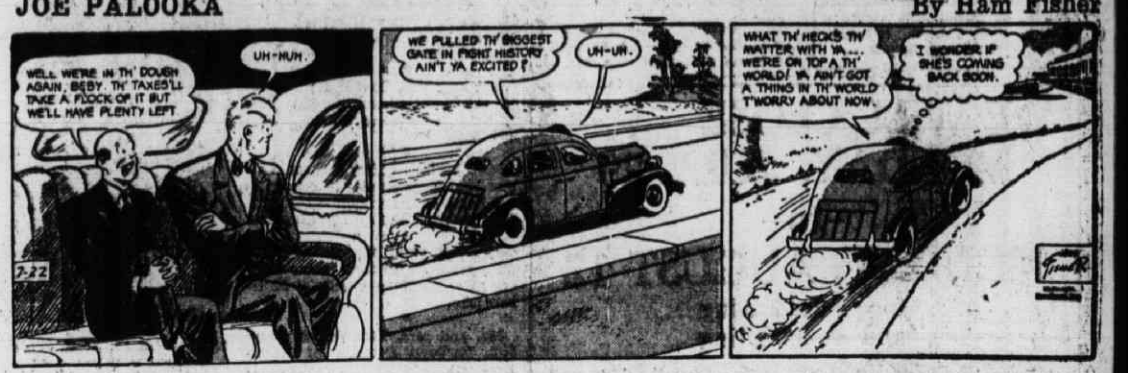


FBI Convicts 97 Pct. Of Cases Investigated
